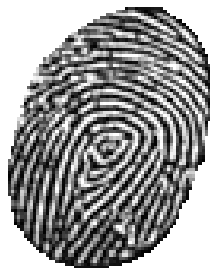

CAMP FEATURES

The camp lasts five full days. Each day starts at 9 am and ends about 4:30 pm. Students participate in discussions, laboratories and field trips. The camp involves college level material covering topics including:

- Crime scene investigation
- Blood analysis
- Analysis of hair and fibers
- Fingerprinting
- DNA analysis
- Ballistics analysis, and more!

REGISTRATION

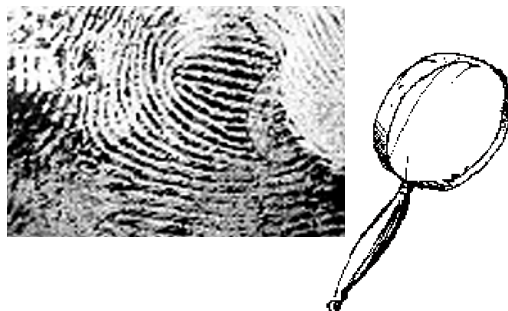
Students will be accepted on a first come first served basis. **Registration deadline is June 1, 2011.**

Enrollment is limited and can only be secured by returning a registration form with appropriate fee as soon as possible. Early registration is encouraged. A cancelled check confirms acceptance into camp. An enrollment letter containing more detailed information will be sent three weeks prior to camp.

On-site check-in for Resident Campers will take place from 4 to 6 pm on Sunday June 26, for Session 1, and Sunday, July 10, for Session 2 in Eaton Hall main lobby. **On-site check-in for Commuter Campers** will take place at 8 am on Monday, June 27 for Session 1, and Monday, July 11 for Session 2 in Eaton Hall Main Lobby. Camp will begin following Commuter Camper check-in.

CANCELLATION POLICY

A \$50 charge will be assessed to all cancellations. All cancellations must be verified at least 2 weeks before camp begins to receive partial refund. No refunds after this 2 week period.
