Voter Registration Information

The fifteenth amendment of the United States Constitution gives citizens the right to vote. McDaniel College encourages all students to exercise this right by completing the voter registration process for their states of residence.

This information is being posted in compliance with Section 487(a)(23) of the Higher Education Act of 1965, which requires higher education institutions to distribute voter registration information and forms to their students.
