RESIDENCE HALL

I understand that the College does not provide health and accident insurance for field trip or special event participants, and I acknowledge that any medical expenses, property loss, or other personal expenditures that result during or from this travel/trip are to be borne by the student/participant, or by their parent or guardian (if student/participant is a minor). Depending on the destination, the College may require trip travel insurance, which would be obtained by the College through an insurer with the cost being included in the cost of the trip. The traveler will be advised if this insurance is required. I also hereby consent and give authorization to trip leaders to secure any emergency medical treatment in the event I am unable to, and I agree to be responsible for the costs thereof.

I further acknowledge that if I drive my own vehicle, or am a passenger in another's private vehicle in connection with this trip/special event, that McDaniel College's insurance does not cover any occurrence resulting from my travel in a private vehicle. I also understand that the College cannot be responsible for assuring the safety and reliability of such private transportation or driver for any non-sponsored activities and travel that I choose to participate in before, during, or after the College sponsored function, and I therefore accept the risks and responsibilities associated with such private vehicle travel.
